LABNOTES

The 327 Federal Magnum is the second and most powerful upgrade of the venerable 32 Smith & Wesson Long cartridge. The first performance upgrade came from Federal Ammunition in 1983 with the 32 H&R Magnum. It used the 32 Long case lengthened to 1.075-inch combined with higher pressures. The 327 Federal has a 1.200-inch case and a maximum average pressure three times that of the original 32 S&W Long. In spite of its name, the 327 Federal uses 0.312-inch bullets, as do the 32 S&W Long and 32 H&R Magnum.

The 327 Federal with the high-performance 100-grain Speer® Gold Dot® hollow point can post velocities from a 3-inch revolver that exceed those of many 125-grain 357 Magnum loads from a 2.5-inch revolver, delivering almost 500 ft-lbs of muzzle energy. The smaller case diameter provides another benefit: compact 327 Federal revolvers hold six cartridges compared to five for similar 38/357 caliber models.

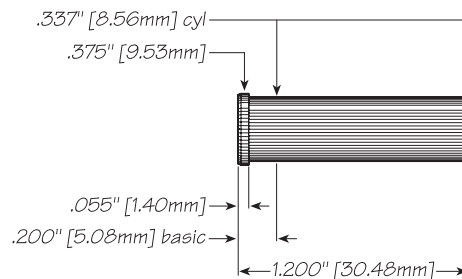
The loads presented here are held slightly under the 45,000 psi maximum average pressure for this cartridge to ensure easy extraction from revolvers. They were function-tested in a Ruger SP-101 and gave no problems of any kind.
